In the firm where he worked, he was hit by a broken high voltage cable and was killed instantly. Although I was a single mother, with the help of my parents I succeeded in educating the children. Branislav attended a two year mechanical engineering college and he is an engineer, and my daughter Vesna finished a two year medical college. I did everything in my power to provide them with a carefree childhood. Whenever I was able, I took them to the seaside. I tried in every way to alleviate the fact that they lost their father so early. I think that I succeeded in this.
