The photo was taken in Plevna in the 1900s. My husband's father was an important egg merchant. He exported production wholesale to Austria. He lived in the town of Plevna. There were such a concurrence of circumstances that he went bankrupt and died. His family moved to Sofia in 1935. They rented a lodging in the town and started to work.
