

2. **Golda** (1893- 1967), (married name -?), housewife, son Motia, died in Kishinev
3. **Adel** (1905-1993),(married name -?) housewife, daughter Haika, died in Israel.
4. **Srul** Mariasis (1899-?)(Lutsk), doctor pediatrician. Children.
5. **Lazar**, Mariasis (1903, - 1980) engineer, sons Arkadiy and Iosif, died in Kishinev.
