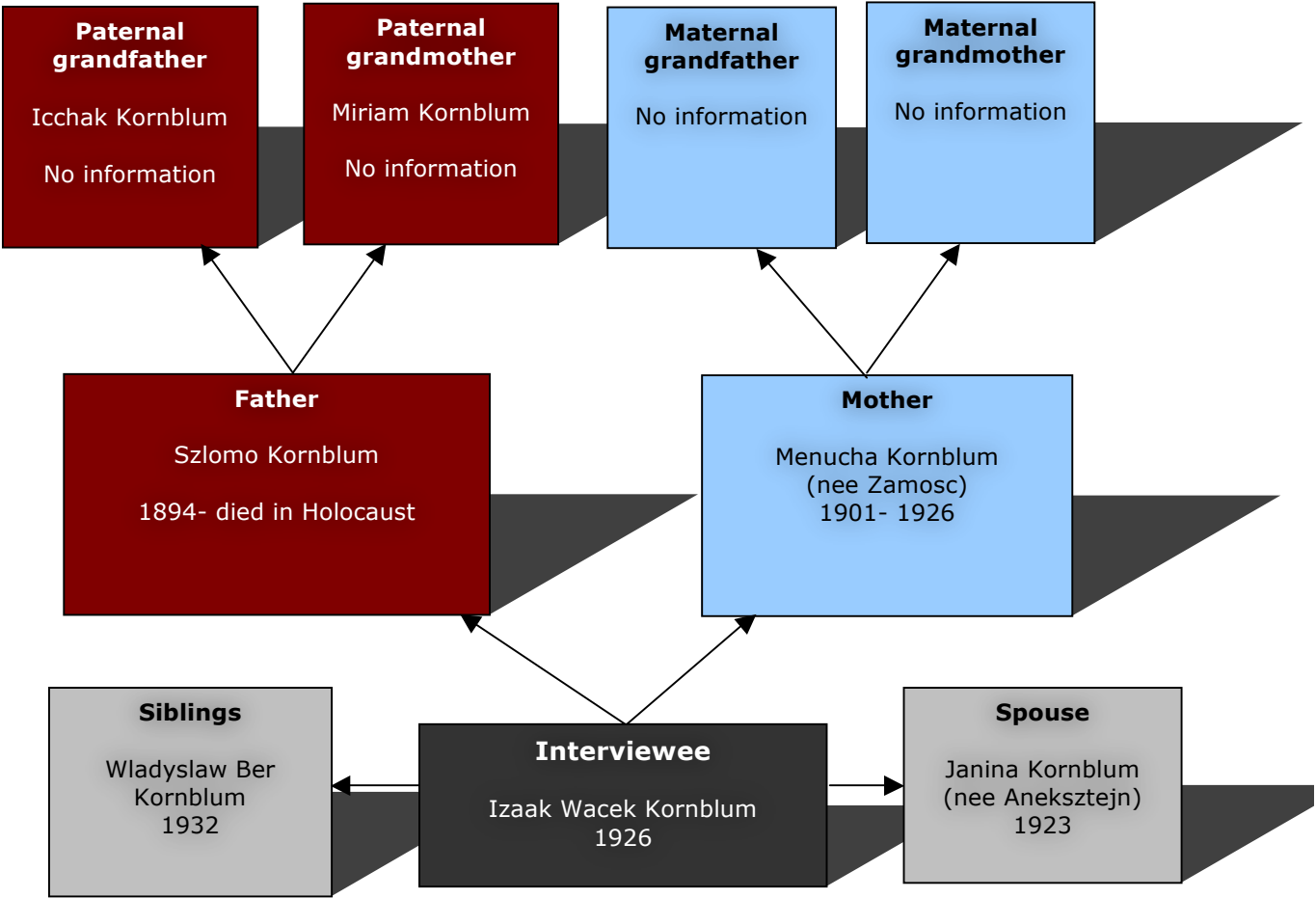


Family Tree

We were not religious. We observed Jewish holidays to keep the tradition. We did not light candles on Friday My parents didn't go to the synagogue. I was never in the synagogue. My bar mitzwah was not religious one.

Polish

How many other languages do you speak?

Hebrew, Yiddish, English.

Where were you during the Holocaust?

In the Warsaw Ghetto and in hiding in the village Kowalewsczyzna (Bialystok region)

What did you do after the Holocaust?

I was in sanatorium in Otwock near Warsaw to heal from tuberculosis. I completed my education and started to work
