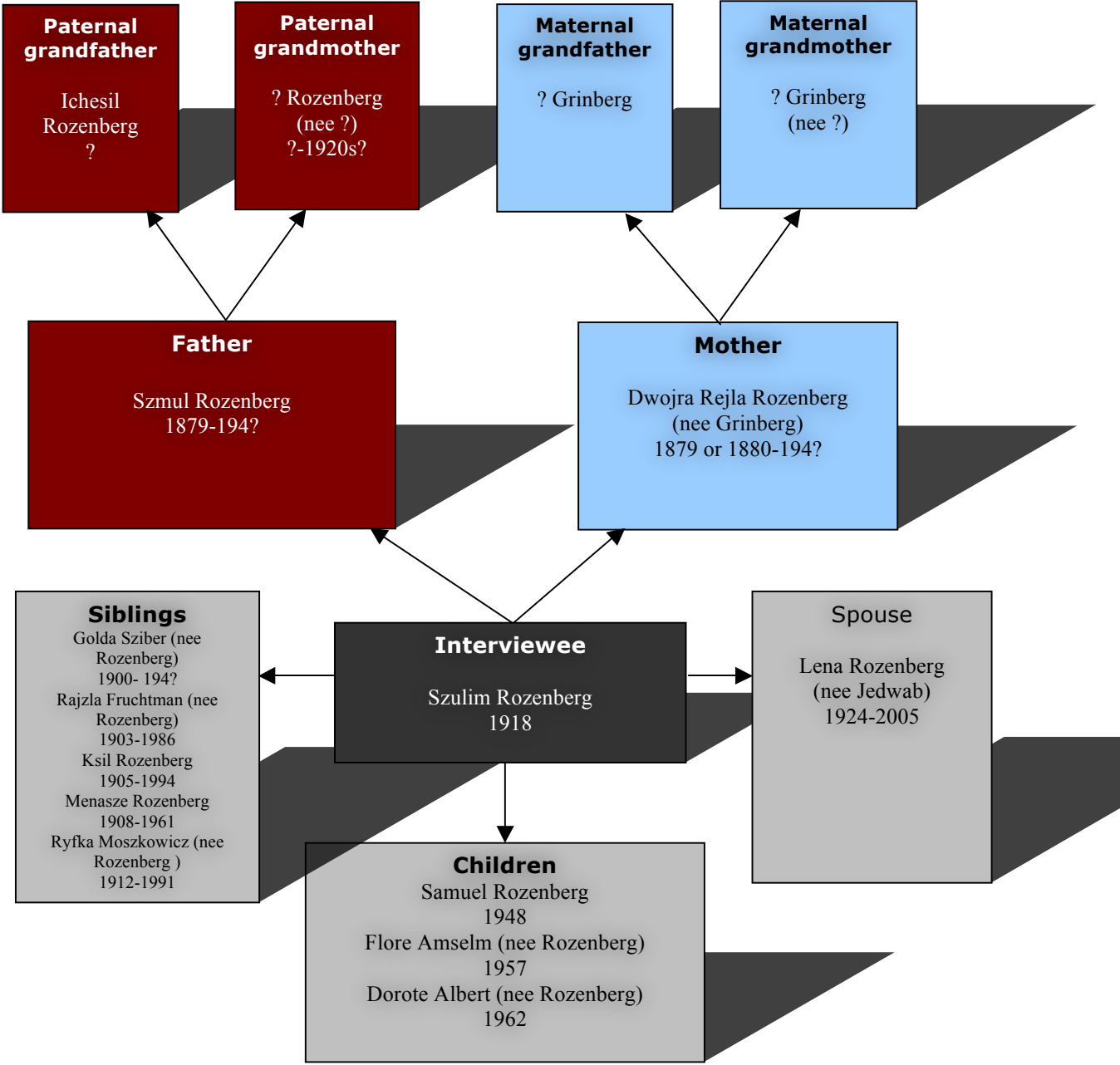


Family Tree

Mother went to the synagogue at every festival. She knew that she wasn't allowed to mix dairy and meat, that this wasn't kosher and that wasn't kosher, so she didn't do it, but whether she was religious? What does 'religiousness' mean? The whole religiousness thing among poor people like that was a bit of a comfort thing, that they would go there [to heaven after death], and it would be

easier there. Mother always went to the mikveh after her period.
